From a young age, she attended the Pebbles Early Childhood Development (ECD) Centre located on Villiera Wines farm, and as she progressed to primary school, she joined the Pebbles After-School Centre on the farm.

Andrea's time at Pebbles took on a new dimension when she joined the Pebbles Youth Development Programme (YDP).

## IMPILO YABAFAZI MOBILE CLINIC

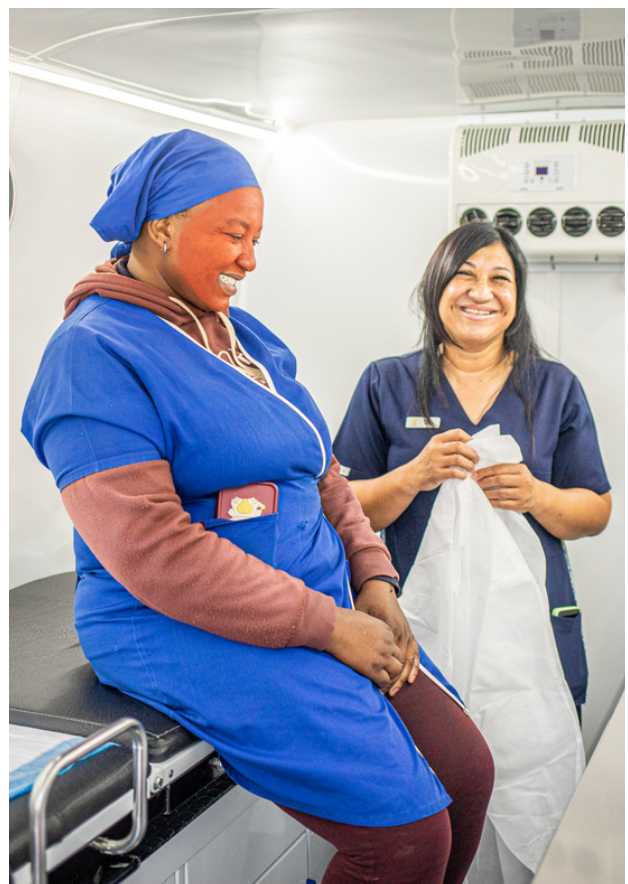
We are delighted to share the launch of our brand new Women's Health Mobile Clinic, sponsored by Texas Children's Global. The mobile clinic brings essential healthcare directly to women across the Western Cape at no cost.

This safe and confidential service ensures that women can access vital preventative care and support within their own communities.

Services offered include:

- Pap smears (Ages 21+)
- Breast screening
- Family planning services
- HIV testing
- Health education
- Blood pressure checks
- Blood glucose (sugar) tests
- Cholesterol tests

To date 54 women accessed cervical, breast, and HIV screenings, supporting early detection and referral for care. The Impilo Yabafazi Mobile Clinic is empowering women to take charge of their health and wellbeing with dignity and confidence.



## NEW YOUTH DEVELOPMENT CENTRE IN STELLENBOSCH

A new Youth Development Centre is currently being built at Villiera Wine Farm in Stellenbosch. The centre, sponsored by the Stichting Garcia Foundation will respond to the growing need for support and skills development within the farming communities we serve. Once completed, it will provide a dedicated space to implement our Youth Development Programme, empowering young people aged 15 to 25 with the skills and opportunities they need to build brighter futures.

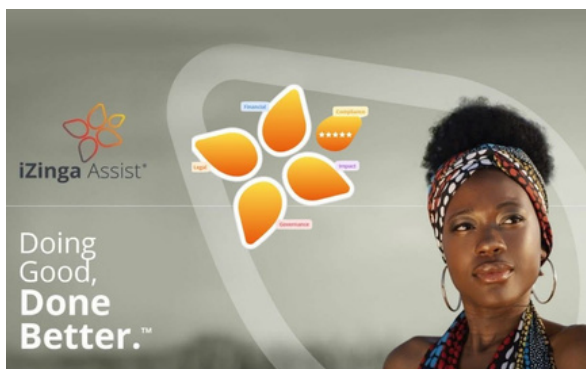
